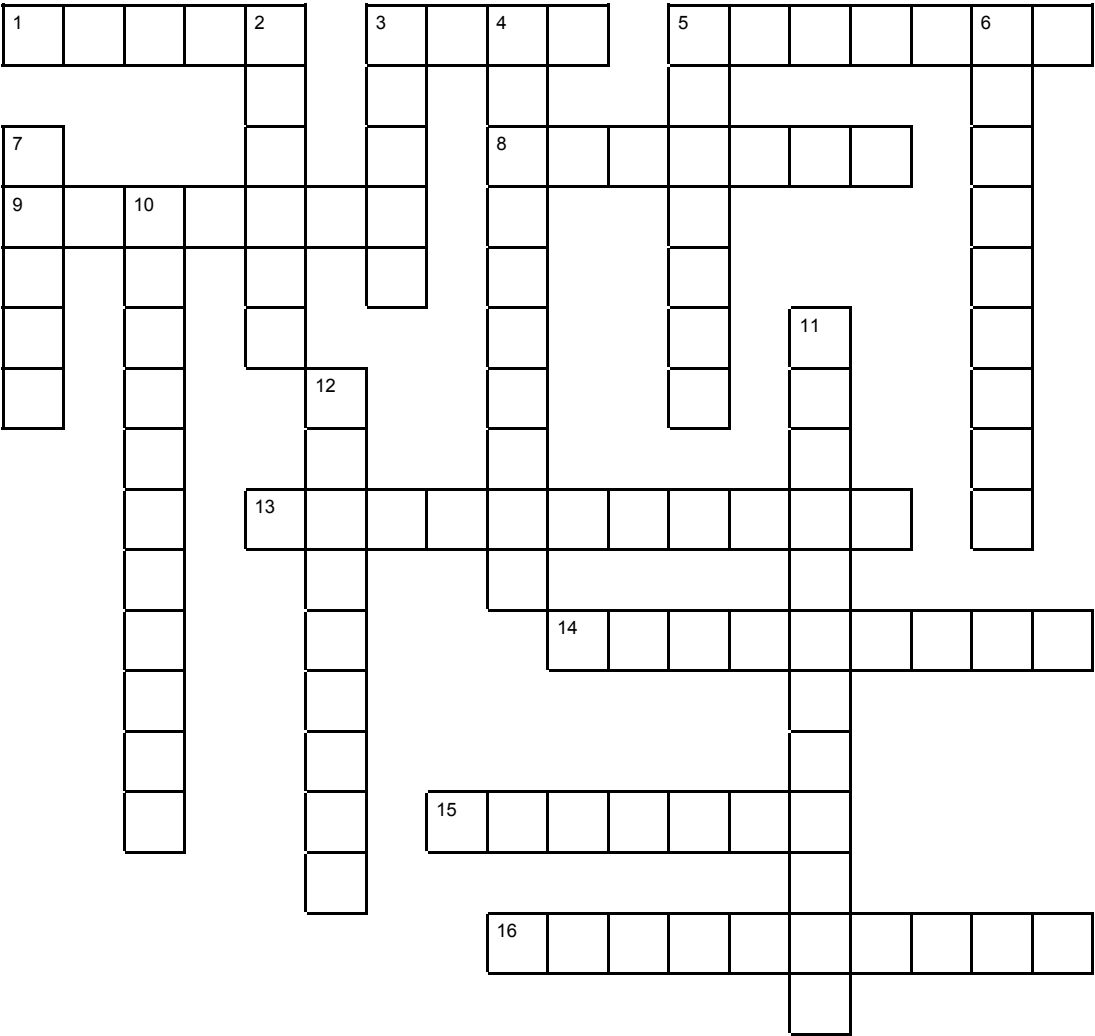


# Acharei Mot

**1** Jews are not allowed to consume this fluid.

**3** On Yom Kippur we abstain from this.

**5** Emotion so intense that one is carried beyond rational thought and self-control

**8** Aim or goal

**9** Term used in the Torah that means “to fast” during Yom Kippur.

**13** Chance occurrence of 2 or more events at one time.

**14** The High Priest may enter the Holy of Holies on this day.

**15** One who overindulges in food, drink, or other activities.

**16** Pledge, promise, obligation

**2** Refusal to recognize or acknowledge, disavow

**3** The High Priest wears special garments of this color on the day he enters the Holy of Holies.

**4** Contrition, regret

**5** Understanding of another’s feelings, motives, situation

**6** The goat who is let loose in the wilderness after the High Priest symbolically laid the sins of the people on its head.

**7** Prohibition

**10** Act of excusing a mistake or offense

**11** To make a careful judgment
