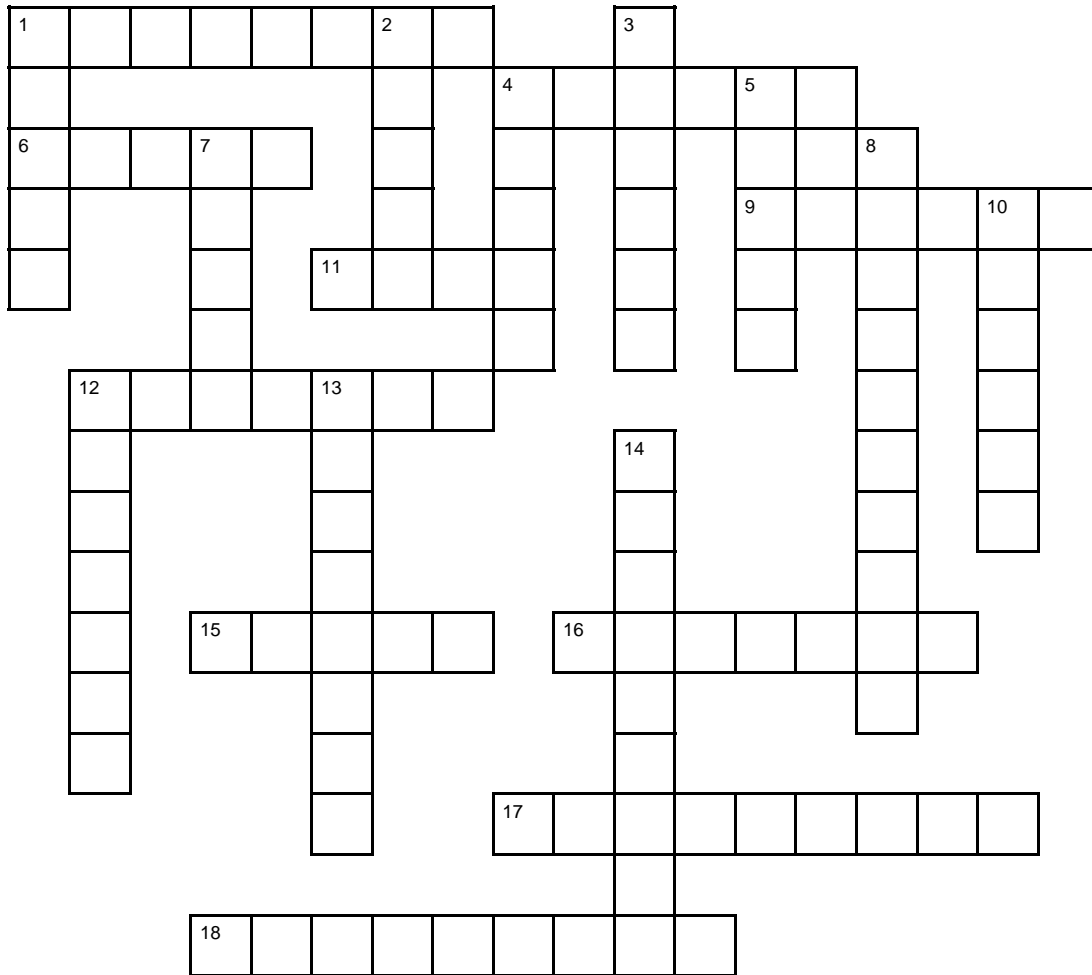


# Balak Crossword Puzzle
