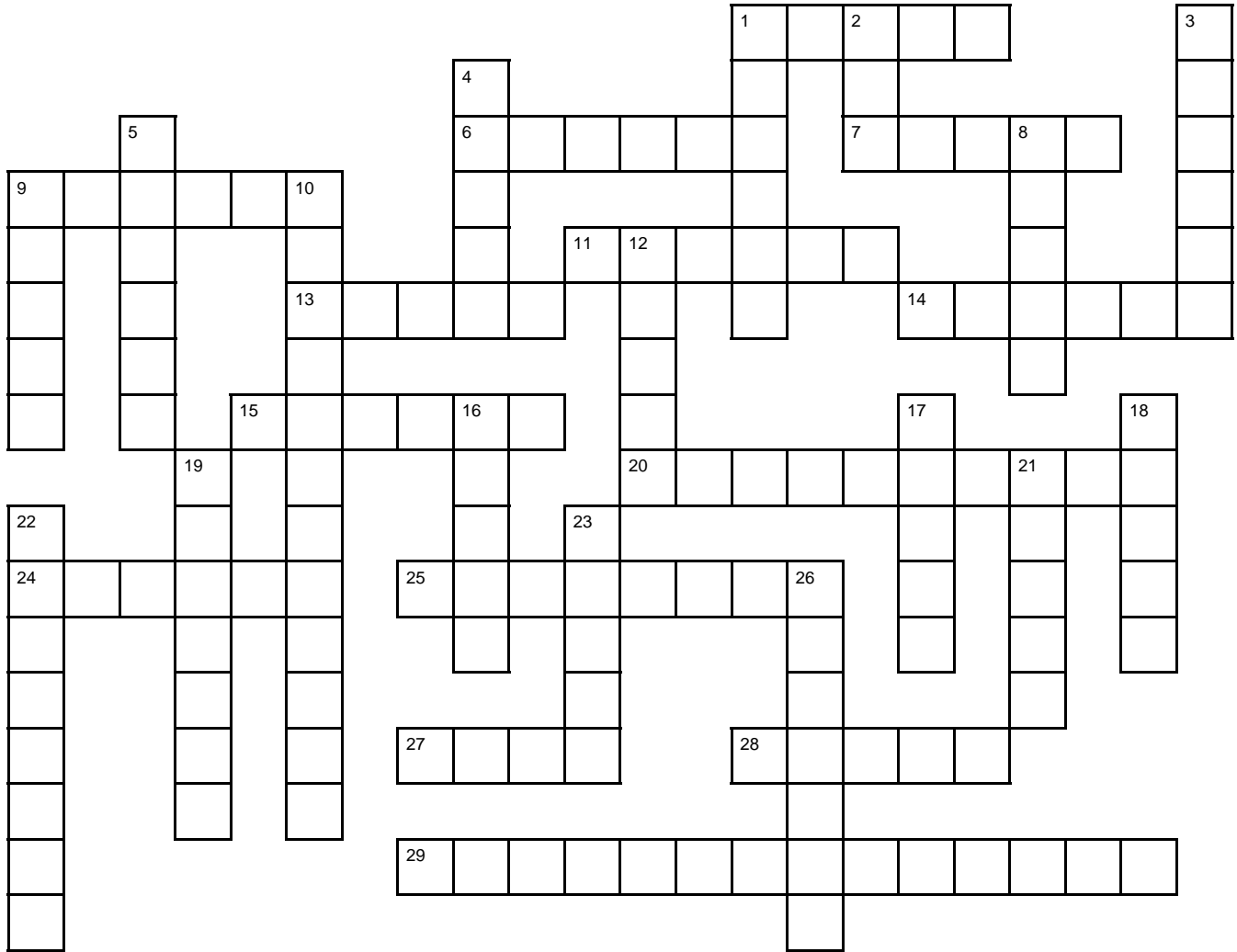


Sukkot Crossword Puzzle



Across

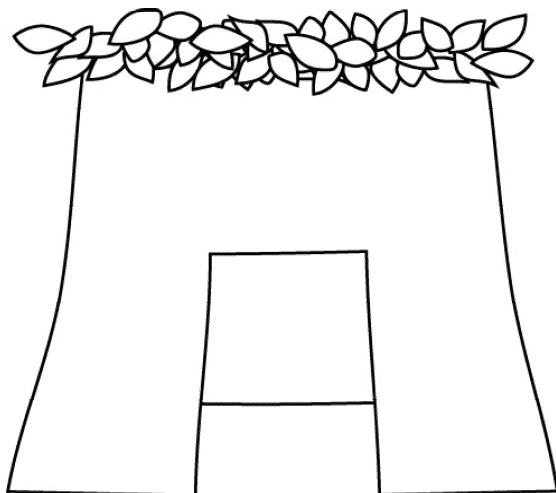
- 1 Ushpizin who ran from Esav and Lavan and had to leave Israel in his old age and go to Egypt. He trusted in G-d.
