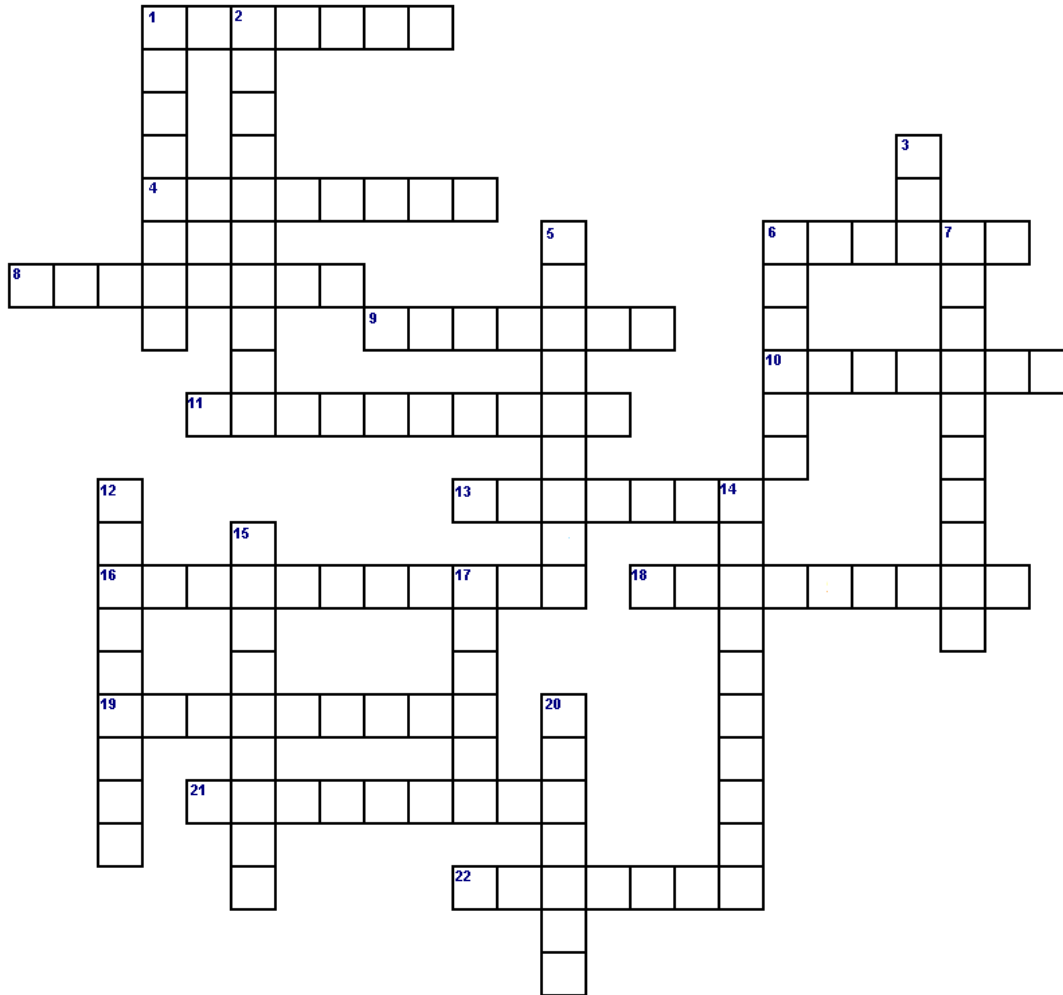


# Trumah
