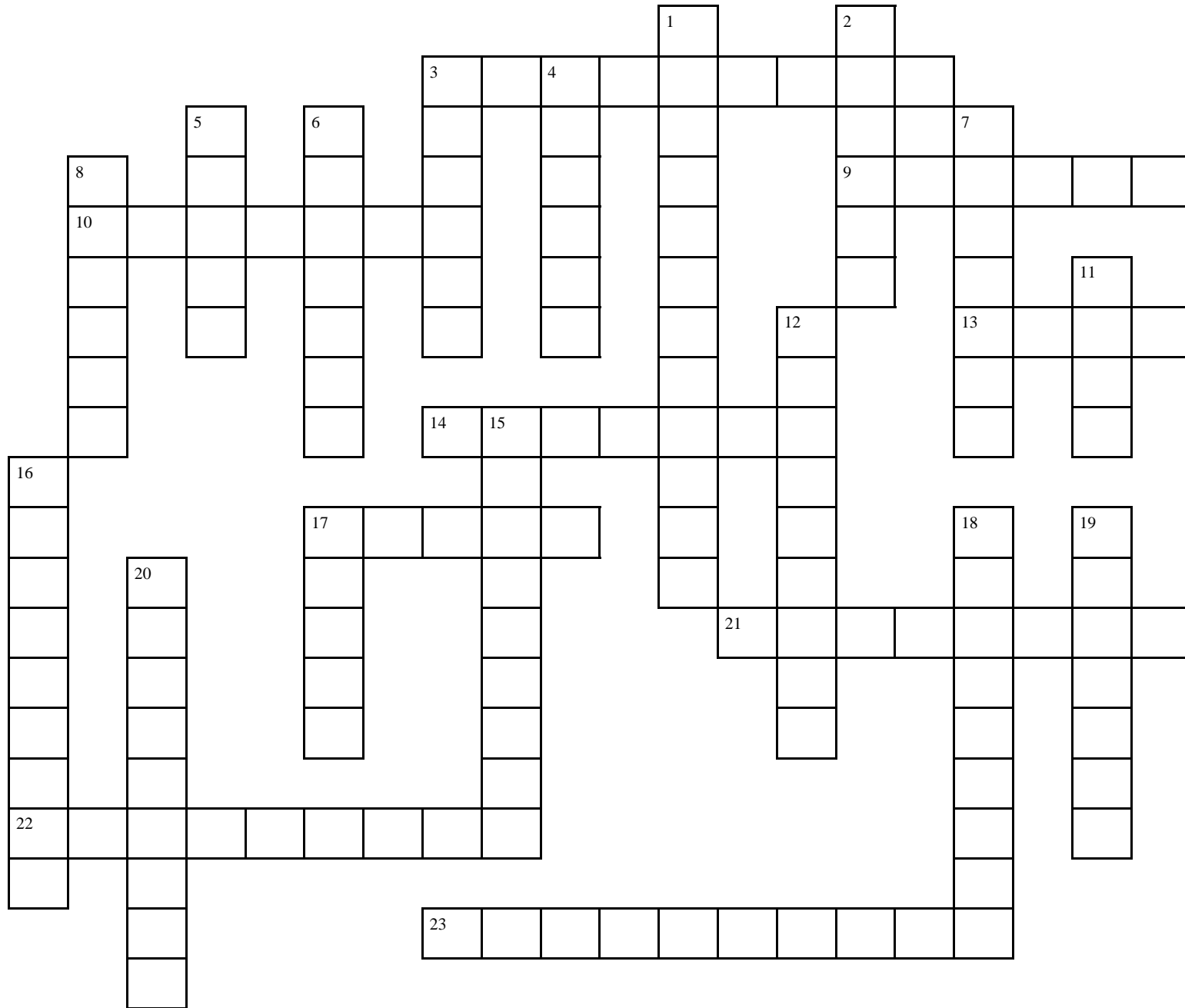


# Vayishlach Crossword Puzzle
