1. APPRINIACTOE    **A P P R E C I A T I O N**  
(Recognition and understanding of the quality, value, significance, or magnitude of people, things and ideas.)
2. PTMLEE    **T E M P L E**  
(The siege on Jerusalem led to the destruction of the King Solomon's \_\_\_\_.)
3. NHUZZEDNRBCAAE    **N E B U C H A D N E Z Z A R**  
(On the Tenth of Tevet, 2,500 years ago, he began his siege of Jerusalem.)
4. ZAER    **E Z R A**  
(This scribe died on the ninth of Tevet. He led the return of the Jews to Jerusalem from their Babylonian exile; reconstituted the dispersed Jewish community on the basis of Torah law; resolved the identity threat which arose by the intermarriage between Jews and foreigners and provided a definite reading of the Torah.)
5. IASASSNEUDMH    **S A D A M    H U S S E I N**  
(He pronounced himself as the reincarnation of Nebuchadnezzar, and dreamed of restoring the Babylonian empire to its former size and glory. Like the ancient king, he faced a similar downfall.)
6. IAYRDF    **F R I D A Y**  
(Tenth of Tevet is observed, even if it falls on this day, Erev Shabbat.)
7. OESRHT    **O T H E R S**  
(To ensure that Torah should not be forgotten, you have to teach what you've learned to \_\_\_\_.)

8. **PTUEASNGTI** **S E P T U A G I N T**  
 (The oldest Greek translation of the five Books of Moses traditionally said to have been translated by 70 or 72 Jewish scholars at the request of Ptolemy II.)
9. **IHENLMLSE** **H E L L E N I S M**  
 (The imitation or adoption of ancient Greek language, thought, customs, art, etc.)
10. **IBAYLANBO** **B A B Y L O N I A**  
 (Nebuchadnezzar was king of this country.)
11. **ABOYLBN** **B A B Y L O N**  
 (This biblical city lies north of the ancient city of Ur on the Euphrates River.)
12. **AROIASDP** **D I A S P O R A**  
 (Dispersion of Jews outside of Israel.)
13. **OTILNSSIAMAI** **A S S I M I L A T I O N**  
 (Merging of cultural traits from previously distinct cultural groups)
14. **DNIGGEAGHSNRAN** **H A N G I N G G A R D E N S**  
 (One of the original Seven Wonders of the World. Nebuchadnezzar built them for his wife who missed the plants and trees of her homeland Persia.)
