SEVEN SPECIES	On Tu B'Shevat, we eat from these.
WHEAT	Grain from cereal grass of genus Triticum.
BARLEY	Grain from cereal grass of genus Hordeum.
GRAPEVINE	Plant of genus Vitus bearing fruit called grapes.
FIG	Fruit of the Ficus carica.
POMEGRANATE	Many-seeded fruit of Punica granatum.
OLIVE	Evergreen tree, Olea europaea, whose unripe fruit is an ochre green or dull yellow green.
DATE HONEY	Made from the syrup of the fruit of a palm tree.
WALNUT	Corrugated seed from a tree of genus Juglans.
ALMOND	Nutlike kernel of fruit from Prunus dulcis or Prunus amara.
PISTACHIO	Greenish nut of the Pistacia vera.
COCONUT	Large, hard-shelled seed of a palm, lined with a white edible meat, and containing a milky liquid.
ORANGE	Citrus fruit named for its color.
AVOCADO	Fruit of genus Persea with green or blackish inedible skin; soft yellowish-green pulp, and large inedible seed.
BLUEBERRY	Bluish berry of the Vaccinium genus.
PEACH	Soft juicy fruit, having yellow flesh, downy, red-tinted yellow skin, and a deeply sculptured stone containing a single, inedible seed.
PLUM	Smooth-skinned, fleshy, dark purple to deep reddish purple, edible fruit of the genus Prunus, with a single hard-shelled, inedible stone that encloses the seed.
WINE	Fermented juice of grapes.
JUICE	Fluid extracted from plant or fruit.
TITHE	Tenth part of agricultural produce or personal income set apart as an offering or to support religious institution.
TREE OF KNOWLEDGE	Tree in the Garden of Eden bearing the forbidden fruit that was tasted by Adam and Eve. Gen. 2:17; 3:6–24.
TREE OF LIFE	Tree in the Garden of Eden that yielded food giving everlasting life. Gen 2:9; 3:22.
POTENTIAL	Possible, capable.
ACTUAL	Existing in act or fact; real.

ACTION	Activity, function, execution, process of doing.
FORMATION	Being arranged, configuration, compilation.
CREATION	Conception, establishment, genesis.
EMANATION	Origin, emergence, arising.
CHERRY	Red, yellow, or blackish fruit of tree of <i>Prunus avium</i> or <i>Prunus cerasus</i> , having inedible seed.
STRAWBERRY	Red fruit of stemless plant belonging to genus <i>Fragaria</i> .
ECOLOGY	The environment as it relates to living organisms.
NATURE	Environment, outdoors, universe, world.
MAN	Tree of the field. Deut. 20:19.
RECYCLE	To make suitable for reuse.
REUSE	Use again.
REDUCE	Decrease, scale down, lessen.
JEWISH NATIONAL FUND	Charitable organization which plants trees, builds dams and reservoirs, develops land and creates parks in Israel.
ENERGY	Generated power, electricity, heat, horsepower.
WATER	Rain, H <sub>2</sub> O, liquid component of rivers, lakes, and oceans.
POLLUTION	Undesirable state of the natural environment being contaminated with harmful substances.
FOREST	Large tract of land covered with trees.
OCEAN	Vast body of salt water that covers almost three fourths of the earth's surface.
ATMOSPHERE	Gaseous envelope surrounding the earth; the air.
