1. Only biblical holiday where this not performed.
2. The early morning service of Yom Kippur.
3. The final service of Yom Kippur.
4. Traditionally, men would wave a white rooster over their heads three times; women would wave a white hen. Next, the bird would be taken to a shochet and then given to the poor. Today, we use money wrapped in a white napkin and donate it to the poor.
5. On Yom Kippur, we neither eat nor drink.
6. Many people do not wear shoes made of this on Yom Kippur.
7. Lit after the Yom Kippur meal.
8. Evening. The evening part of a day, which precedes the morning part of the same day because a “day” on the Jewish calendar starts at sunset.
9. The afternoon service of Yom Kippur.
10. Ten days from Rosh Hashanah to Yom Kippur, a time for introspection and considering the sins of the previous year.
11. White robes in which the dead are buried. Some wear this on Yom Kippur.
12. Rosh Hashanah, the Days of Awe and Yom Kippur are known as ____.
13. After the final shofar blast after the Ne’ila service, the congregation says, “Next year in ____!”
14. The second service of Yom Kippur.
15. Shabbat ____ is the sabbath between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Special Haftarah regarding repentance and Divine mercy are read.
16. Day of Atonement. A day set aside for fasting, depriving oneself of pleasures, and repenting from the sins of the previous year.
17. This is only worn after dark in a Yom Kippur prayer service. Otherwise, it is worn at morning prayer services.
18. The evening service of Yom Kippur. “All vows.”
19. Prayers for forgiveness; added to liturgy in the month of Elul.
